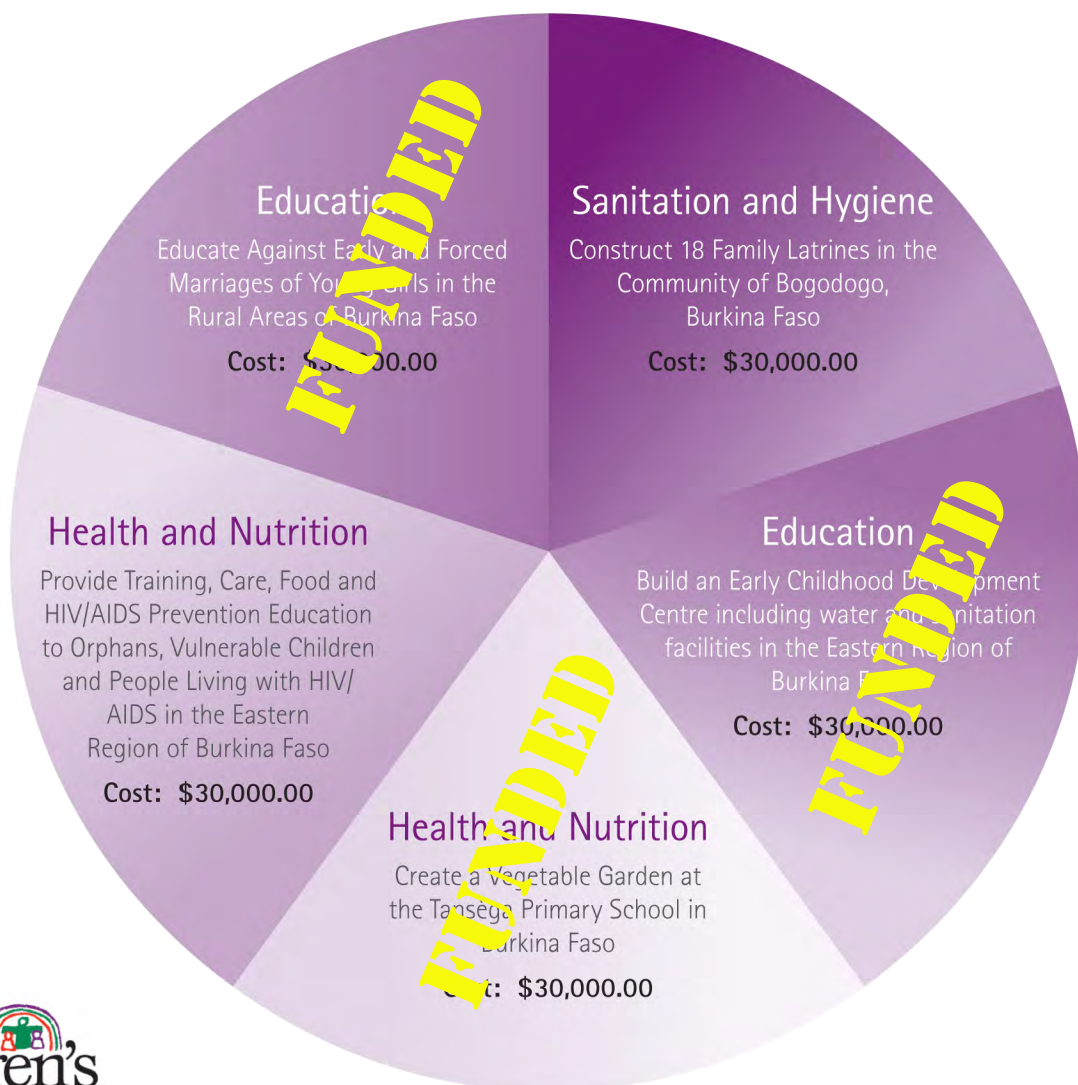
Burkina Faso

Formally known as Upper Volta, Burkina Faso is a landlocked country in West Africa cradled in a savannah plateau traversed by three major rivers that merge in Ghana to become the Volta. The average temperature during the day is 30 degrees Celsius. The terrain is mainly arid grassland, with hills in the west and southwest and desert to the north.

Making a living in Burkina Faso is hard. One of the poorest countries in the world, almost half of the entire population of Burkina Faso lives below the poverty line.
